Refresher Programs for Registered & Enrolled Nurses

Royal Perth Hospital in conjunction with the Department of Health, Workforce Development, conducts a four week, fulltime program which enables Registered and Enrolled nurses who are currently registered with the Nurses and Midwives Board of WA, but have not practiced for up to five years to update their knowledge and skills to work in the acute health care setting.

The program integrates theory and clinical practice, through lectures and workshops that are presented by experienced clinicians from a wide variety of backgrounds and expertise.

The theoretical component is conducted at Shenton Park Campus while the clinical practice can be undertaken at various metropolitan and regional participating hospitals.

While on clinical placement, the student is supernumerary and supported by a preceptor and education staff. Mentoring is provided by the course coordinator who is available to support the student, from the application process to organising clinical placement.

There is no cost to the individual to undertake this program and financial assistance is available to applicants who are willing to commit to working in a government health organisation for twelve months following completion of the program.
